Conditions of Sale Entry

- Heifers must pass a pre-sale on farm inspection prior to entry into the catalogue.
- Each animal listed must be accompanied by entry fee of €10.
- All heifers to show on their National ID Cards SI or SIX (the cross being a Simmental bull) and should be of Simmental appearance.
- Pedigree heifers must be de-registered in advance of the sale.
- All heifers to be registered in the seller's herd for a minimum of 3 months prior to the sale date.
- All sellers to know the breeding of their females, e.g. bloodlines of stock bull or Al.
- Testing Requirements: Export Tested highly recommended but not a requirement.
- All in-calf Cows/Heifers should be scanned and certified in calf by a veterinary surgeon with an accurate calving date.
- All in-calf Cows/Heifers in calf to AI should have an accompanying AI docket.
- If in-calf to a stock bull, have an accurate service date accompanied by a photocopy of the bull's pedigree certificate.
- All Maiden heifers are to be genuine breeding heifers i.e. never having had a calf and having the ability to go in-calf.
- It is adviser that maiden heifers are scanned suitable for breeding
- Only cattle entered on official entry forms will be admitted to the sale.
- All cattle to be penned by 5.30pm on evening of the sale.
- The committee reserves the right to refuse admission or to reject entries.
- Heifers are deemed to be maiden unless entered in the in-calf section onus on the breeder/exhibitor.
- Inspections will take place on Saturday 21st and Sunday 22nd of September
