Dear Simmental Breeder,

Presently we are planning to hold our sale in Roscommon as normal but as we are too aware this sale will not run as normal. We propose leaving it as close as possible to catalogue completion to make the final decisions regarding the running of this sale. (This due to the ever-changing protocols around mart sales etc).

It is very likely that there may not be a show element to this sale and we may also be required to place a cap on animals allowed into the sale. If this is the situation and entries exceed this number, Council will decide on a formula to reduce entry numbers. The other major issue will centre around the presence of sellers and customers with limits on current numbers permitted entry to mart premises. A full update will be sent to all with animals entered prior to any TB testing by September 26<sup>th</sup>.

Finally, please be mindful that we will always have to follow NPHET & DAFF protocol which could at any stage cancel sales.

Premier Sale – Export Standard (Animals must be TB Tested within 30 days of the sale & PLEASE NOTE that there must be 45 days between previous test to be EXPORT ELIGIBLE)

### 3. **DNA Sampling**

Council strongly encourages Breeders to have all animals offered for sale parentage verified either through standard DNA or through the new Genomics scheme (BDGP)

#### 4. Entry Numbers Per Breeder

#### Maximum Entry Numbers Permitted for "A" Members

- 10 Registrations in 2019 4 Entries per sale on a 3 + 1 rule (not greater of 3 of one sex)
- 11 20 Registrations in 2019 6 Entries per sale on a 4 + 2 rule (not greater of 4 of one sex)
- 21 30 Registrations in 2019 8 Entries per sale on a 5 + 3 rule (not greater of 5 of one sex)
- 31 40 Registrations in 2019 10 Entries per sale on a 6 + 4 rule (not greater of 6 of one sex)
- 41+ Registrations in 2019 12 Entries per sale on a 7 + 5 rule (not greater of 7 of one sex)

#### Maximum Entry Numbers Permitted for "B" Members

#### 9. Fertility Testing

While Fertility testing is not an entry requirement, it is recommended that breeders consider having their bulls tested prior to sale.

To: All Exhibitors,

As we prepare for this year's Premier Sale at Roscommon, we are unsure as to what format this sale will take and if we will even have a physical show element to the event.

Council has decided to host Videos of entries for exhibitors on its Website. These video's will be uploaded once the catalogue is completed and a latest date for receipt of such video's will be circulated to exhibitors in advance. (Depending on regulations at the time of sale these videos maybe used as part of the sale system).

<u>Video Purpose</u> – The purpose of going to the effort and possible cost of preparing such a video is that it will add to the promotion of your animal. Therefore, it is very important that these videos are of good quality and Council will in the view of its committee not publish any material that in its opinion takes from the potential sale of the animal in question.

Options - The two options available to exhibitors to prepare such a video are,

- a) Employ a professional There maybe an opportunity to arrange a group price from the contractor if a few breeder's pool together.
- b) Home Video The most important thing here is to focus on featuring the quality of your entry.

Video Length – The video must not be more that 20 seconds in length.

Note: If you are going with a Home Video seek help from a friend / neighbour if necessary.
